I was born on July 3, 1947 in Clovis, New Mexico. I grew up in Clovis and worked for my family which owned a large farming and ranching operation. My family also owned the Citizens Bank of Clovis of which I am currently part owner. Graduated Clovis High School in 1965 and attended New Mexico State University in Las Cruces from 1965 until 1969. I married Connie Marie Mourning in 1969 in Las Cruces and we just celebrated our 40th wedding anniversary. We have a son, married with two kids living in Colleyville, Texas and a daughter, married and living in Driftwood, Texas. Both are graduates of the University of Texas at El Paso.

I moved from Lubbock to El Paso in 1979 while employed as a supervisor by the Texas Health Department.

For the last 30 years I have owned and operated L & J Car Washes, Inc.. L & J owns/operates 6 self-service car washes around El Paso. L & J operates as Kwik Car Wash and has 2 locations on the west side, 3 in the Mission Valley and 1 in the northeast.

Served on the board of directors and was president of the Southwest Car Wash Association (SCWA). SCWA is a regional car wash association with approximately 1100 members from Texas, New Mexico, Colorado, Oklahoma and Louisiana. I was awarded SCWA Self Serve Carwash Owner of the year for our location on N. Resler in El Paso.
