SUBJECT:

Approve budget transfers to increase the appropriations of the State Confiscated Award by \$572,205 for a total FY 2010 allocation of \$597,609 and the Federal Confiscated Award by \$831,069 for a total FT 2010 allocation of \$1,875,166 to fund the Police Department's FY 2010 Confiscated Fund budget.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

Funds received from state and federal confiscated funds have to be used in furthering law enforcement activities. The proposed FY 2010 Confiscated Fund budget will allow EPPD to implement essential personnel employment contracts, community outreach and information, technology system solutions, public safety gear and equipment facility improvements and provide cash match for new department grants.

PRIOR COUNCIL ACTION:

The City Council annually approves the budget transfers supporting the Police Department's FY Confiscated Fund budget.

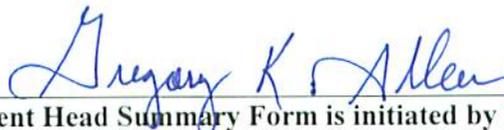

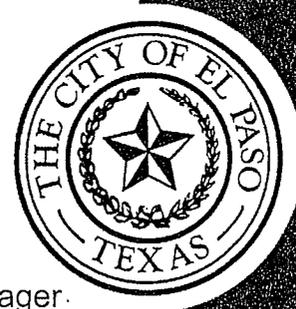

Funds received from state and federal confiscations must be used to further law enforcement activities. The proposed FY 2010 Confiscated Fund budget will allow the Department to implement essential personnel employment contracts, community outreach and information, technology system solutions, facility improvements, and provide cash match for new department grants.

The FY 2010 Confiscated Fund program totals \$1,875,166. In addition to existing programmed funding that remains available from FY 2009, the program requires an additional \$597,609 in state confiscated funds and \$1,277,557 in federal confiscated funds to be programmed per the attached budget transfers. Major purchases (greater than \$20,000) for the FY 2010 Confiscated Fund program are summarized below for your convenience:

- a. Personnel employment contracts, including:
 1. Police Media Relations Aide contract. This position is needed to provide assistance to the Police Public Information Officer. This position assists in planning, developing and implementing public information and community outreach programs and manages and responds to news media and customer inquiries. This position is budget at .63 FTE. - \$28,288.
- b. Contractual Services and information technology, including:
 1. Leased vehicles for Internal Affairs, – Take-home vehicles to increase the effectiveness of the IA unit by allowing them to respond quicker to incidents where EPPD employees are alleged to have committed major misconduct, as well as officer-involved shootings - \$128,448;
 2. JIMS upgrade and maintenance - \$20,000;
 3. New Defensive Tactic Curriculum for Training Academy- \$114,000 (second year costs of a 3 year contract);

4. Outside consultants – Professional Development Institute for the audit and report related to department's state mandated annual Racial Profiling Report. Drug-testing for officers to comply with the new MOU requirements. Outside expert testimony. \$150,000
- b. Facility improvements, including:
1. Furniture and fixture upgrades for regional commands, and proposed Internal Affairs move to a new facility. Pebble Hill Regional Command will replace furniture and reconfigure office space due in increase in personnel and functions. \$383,860;
 2. Bomb Squad Magazine – Construction of a storage facility for Bomb Squad explosives for CALEA compliance. Additional funds required - \$68,154;
- c. Equipment and operations improvements, including
1. Public safety gear for officers and ComSar - \$41,975
 2. Undercover operations supplies and materials, to include informant funding - \$60,000;
 3. Paging services -\$50,000
 4. Training and associated travel - \$225,000;
 5. Bicycles, racks, lights and bags - \$20,000;
 6. Vehicle Liens – Funding to clear vehicle liens for confiscated vehicles - \$20,000;
 7. Helicopter maintenance supplies/part and fuel. \$45,000
 8. Data processing equipment to include computers (approximately 110), printers, scanners, Citrix software/hardware/licenses, micro reader, ILEADS upgrade, and maintenance contract for Agency Web. \$85,815;
- d. Grant application grant cash matches projected to total \$200,000 in FY 2010.
