# Allocation of \$500,000

- Pets Alive Voucher Program-\$100,000
- Continue TNR (Trap-Neuter-Release) Efforts and Increased Adoption Efforts-\$150,000
- Support the offset costs of a Non-profit Low-cost Spay and Neuter Clinic-\$250,000



# Cleaning, Disinfection, and Sanitizing Protocol

- Procedure implemented twice daily
- Animals are removed from the kennel or run
- Scan the animal
- Removal of solid fecal material-pooper scoop and rinsed with water
- Scrubbing of the walls, door, windows and floor
- Allow 10 minutes to sit with disinfectant
- Rinse the area with water
- Squeegee the floor and windows
- Place animal back in designated area
- Add food and water



# Intake of Animals

- Create an Animal ID number
- Entrance of all required information (breed, gender, color, size, ID tag, collar, tattoo, microchip, hair type)
- Call owner if microchip is present
- Document injuries or illness
- Placement in a kennel or run-size appropriate.



# Housing-Healthy Animals

- Health & Safety Code Ch. 823
- Male and Female separation
- Size
- Injured animals housed separately-provided care within legal limits
- Kennel size-range from:  
2.5"(d)x2.5"(h)x2"(w) to 2.5"(d)x2.5"(h)x3.8"(w)
- Run size-4' X 8' X 8' feet tall
- Temperature in the building-72 degrees F, will be adjusted as outside conditions fluctuate



# Housing-Sick or Quarantined Animals

- Sick animals - Quarantine A ONLY
- Animals involved in Bite Cases-Quarantine B
- Injured Animals – S Ward
- Animals are housed in a kennel or run that is size appropriate
  - Stand, turn around, and lay down
- Observed by staff twice daily



# Disease Control

- Separation of symptomatic animals after showing signs
- Implementation of :
  - Footbaths
  - Protective coverings
  - Hand Sanitizer
  - Hand washing sinks and paper towel dispensers
  - Better drainage system
- Always looking into other methods that can be implemented to make Animal Services better
