1. Call to Order

2. Approval of Minutes

Motion by Mr. Eyberg, *seconded by Mr. Chavez, and **unanimously carried to approve the minutes***

3. Changes to the Agenda

Mr. Austin requested Item 9 be postponed.

4. Call to the Public (Items not listed on the agenda)

Mr. Eyberg shared his recent bicycle journey.

5. Discussion and Action on Revisions to Subsection 15.08.120(J)(6) of the El Paso City Code to Revise and Clarify Locational Requirements for Bicycle Racks Installed on Public Right-of-Way.

Ms. Hester, Planning & Inspections Department, presented.

Motion made to move forward by Mr. White with the recommendation to further study minimum requirements, seconded by Mr. Chavez.

6. Discussion and Action on Proposed Changes to Section 20.14.110 of the City of El Paso Municipal Code to Revise and Clarify Standards for Bicycle Parking.

Alfredo Austin, Streets & Maintenance Department, presented.

Motion made to move forward by Mr. White with the recommendation to further study minimum requirements, seconded by Mr. Eyberg.

11. Discussion and Action on BAC Recommendations on Resurfacing and Striping Plan for Lee Boulevard

BAC members expressed concerns about current status of green paint use on restriping and resurfacing projects.

Motion made by Mr. White to recommend approval of proposed striping plan with the additional recommendation that a bike box be introduced at the intersection of Lee and Montwood, seconded by Mr. Gutierrez.

12. Discussion and Action on BAC Recommendations on Proposed Restriping of Edgemere between Pendleton and Lee Boulevard

Motion made by Mr. Gutierrez to recommend approval of proposed restriping plan with the additional recommendation for the extension of puppy track at the entrance of Quest at Edgemere, and consideration for “Yield to Bikes” sign instead of “Share the Road” sign, seconded by Mr. Chavez.

13. Update on Jose Cordova’s Ghost Bike

BAC requested additional procedural information reference Ghost Bikes.
