

AMENDMENT TO LEASE

This Amendment to Lease is made this 5th day of December, 1989, by and between the City of El Paso, a home rule municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "City" and Paso Del Norte Streetcar Preservation Society, Inc., a Texas nonprofit corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Lessee", amending the Lease Agreement dated December, 10, 1985 and the subsequent Amendment to Lease dated December 8, 1987;

WITNESSETH

Paragraph 3 shall be amended to read as follows:

3. Paragraph four of the original lease is hereby amended to read:

"Lessee agrees that should it fail to have a streetcar transportation system operating within an area designated by mutual agreement by the 10th day of December 1992, Lessee shall return the nine streetcars at its own expense to the City to a location within the City, designated by the Director of Purchasing; provided, however, that delays caused by natural disasters, acts of God, strikes or other events beyond the control of Lessee shall serve to extend the time of performance."

Except as herein amended, the original provisions of the Lease Agreement dated December 10, 1985 and subsequent Amendment to Lease dated December 8, 1987 shall remain in effect.
